- The 2026 annual packets which provide owners with important information regarding the HOA's financial position, annual dues payments, elections, and more will be sent out soon. - The HOA irrigation has been turned off and will be winterized in the next few weeks.
- We have two (2) new homes under construction on Lookout Lane which can get very narrow. Please slow down and be aware there may be heavy machinery in the roadway at times.

- Lake SGR (aka the detention pond), on the right as you enter the community from 27 Road, will
 soon be water free. We had to order a part that controls the electricity to the pump which will be
 installed as soon as it arrives. This is expected to resolve the issue and keep the water drained
 going forward.
- The swimming pool reconstruction is almost complete, and the new cool decking is done. The final steps of installing the cover and safety rails are happening now and then the pool will be closed for the winter. I know this summer was frustrating for many of you and wanted to thank everyone for being patient through the reconstruction!
